PUBLIC SAFETY ANOUNCEMENT

The Susanville Police Department is reminding citizens to prepare for WINTER SNOW REMOVAL throughout the city.

The City of Susanville currently has an ordinance which becomes effective whenever there is three inches of snow or ice, on any part of the roadway. During these conditions, vehicles may not be parked or left unattended on any city street. As a result, vehicles may be towed immediately at the owner's expense.

Also in accordance with the California Vehicle Code: Vehicles left standing on any public street or alley for more than 72 consecutive hours may be towed at the owner's expense.

The Susanville Police Department is requesting the cooperation of citizens to move all utility/travel trailers, boats and inoperative vehicles that are left parked on the city streets. We also ask that you move basketball hoops that are on or adjacent to the street so they do not interfere with snowplowing.

Private property owners concerned about abandoned vehicles on their own property may tow these vehicles in accordance with the guidelines outlined in Section 22658 of the California Vehicle Code. An explanation of this section for property owners is available at the Susanville Police Department.
